We are a big organization for animals. We love animals and we want to stop cruelty to animals¹.

Here in Bristol there are the *Animals Home* and the *Animal Clinic*.

Every year we find new families for thousands of animals, like cats, dogs, rabbits, guinea pigs and birds.

We don't get any money from the government². So money is always a problem. We get our money only from sponsors.

Some people like our work but haven't got any money to give to us. These people work here as volunteers. They come to our *Animals Home* and help us with the animals.
